PUBLIC LEADERSHIP

The FIIAPP contributes to the development of new political leaderships which respect legality, plurality and diversity; do not reject negotiation and dialogue; can generate alliances and accords or reach agreements; are respected; care for the general interest; are sensitive to the demands of the public; care for the opinions and perceptions of people of the degree of solidarity that society offers them; and that assume transparency and accountability.





The training activities, which focus mainly on Latin American countries, target three different levels:

POLITICAL

Training and research aimed at strengthening political parties.

PUBLIC POLICY

Training of decision makers, exchange of experiences in order to improve policies, promoting dialogue and analysis.

PUBLIC MANAGEMENT

Training central and local administration public sector executives at the technical level.
