### PUBLIC TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE AND CONSULTING

It dispatches highly specialised technicians and professionals to execute programmes, projects and other cooperation activities.

## A PUBLIC SECTOR PLAYER

The FIIAPP is governed by a board of trustees drawn entirely from the public sector, comprising among others the First Vice Presidency, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Cooperation, the Ministry of Justice and the Ministry of Equality.

One of the FIIAPP's objectives is to strengthen institutional and individual capabilities, and this is one of the strategic areas of Spain's 2009-2012 Director Plan for Cooperation. The Plan also covers democratic governance as one of its priority sectors.

The FIIAPP takes part in the main European cooperation programmes -twinning, TAIEX, EUROsocial, URB-AL III, etc.- and in tenders of EuropeAid and other international bodies.

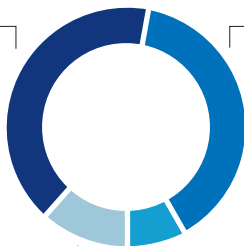
## ORIGIN OF THE INCOMES OF THE FIIAPP
