The International and Ibero-American Foundation of Public Administration and Policies (Fundación Internacional y para Iberoamérica de Administración y Políticas Públicas, **FIIAPP**) in consortium with the International Centre for Migration Policy Development (ICMPD), the European Centre for Development Policy Management (ECDPM), the European Consultants Organization (ECO) and France Coopération Internationale (FCI) is bidding for a technical assistance project within the framework of the European Development Fund (EDF)-financed 'Intra-ACP Migration Facility' (African, Caribbean and Pacific Group of States).

This project will aim to build the capacities of:

- Regional and national institutions in order to incorporate the migration and development element into development policies,
- The civil society so that it can participate in institutional political dialogue on migratory issues.

Another objective of the project will be to ensure coherence with the planned creation of an ACP observatory on migration. The project will be implemented by a Brussels based Project Management Unit (PMU), which will monitor and coordinate a team of 12 specialist technical assistants and a pool of short-term experts, assigned to the six ACP regions.

The consortium led by ICMPD is looking for 12 specialists in institutional and public policy reinforcement in the ACP countries with a strong sensibility towards migratory questions.

Qualification and Experience

Advanced University degree in either administrative (public administration, law) or social sciences (economics, political science, international relations, demography, history, etc.); excellent knowledge of French and English; sound knowledge of migratory issues and preferable familiarity with ACP countries; high level of computer literacy.

Minimum of 10 years of professional experience in either one of the following domains: institutional capacities reinforcement, support to civil society, State Reform and ACP Institutions, Policy design, Strengthening Rule of Law and migratory studies.

Good knowledge of ACP countries and at least of one ACP region.
Excellent writing, reporting and negotiating skills.
