She has been Secretary of State for Immigration; Secretary for the European Union in the Generalitat de Catalunya and member of the EU Committee of the Regions. Previously she was a Member of the European Parliament (1994-2004), spokesperson in the Committee on Civil Liberties, Justice and Home Affairs and member of the Foreign Affairs Committee.

Between 2012 and 2019 she was special advisor to Cecilia Malmström, Commissioner for Home Affairs and later for Trade of the European Commission.

She has taught, as a collaborator, at the Blanquerna Faculty of Communication and International Relations, Ramon Llull University.

She is a member of the Transatlantic Migration Council of the Migration Policy Institute, a member of the European Council of Foreign Relations and of the Board of Directors of 'Friends of Europe'.

She is a member of the Scientific Council of the Real Instituto Elcano and is Patron ad-personam of the CIDOB Foundation.
